Come join us for a guided trail ride with an introduction to endurance riding.

This will be a hands-on educational experience for those interested in learning more about endurance riding. You will have the opportunity to learn the basics of endurance riding including following trail markers and see a “dry camp” set up. The guided ride is approximately 2.6 miles, and the terrain is an easy ride across a cow pasture, down an old park road, through some woods, and then circles back to our starting point. Attendees will learn to “vet in” prior to the start of an endurance ride as well as complete the vet check at the conclusion of the ride, which includes checking their horse’s heartrate with a stethoscope, determining horse’s hydration, lameness issues, etc.

- Any breed of horse or mule is welcome. **There will be a limit of 15 horses and/or mules.**
- Shoes are NOT required (or necessary).
- You may ride in the tack you and your horse are most comfortable in (Western, Endurance, etc.).
- Please leave your dogs at home. If you bring a dog, it **MUST be in your truck or trailer at all times.**
- Dress for the temperature, this is a 100% outdoor event.
- **ALL horses on premises must have a current negative Coggins (issued in the last 12 months).**
- The Ride Organizer reserves the right to remove any person who is disruptive to the ride or endangers the safety of others.
- **RSVP with the number of riders and horses in your party by Wednesday, November 1, to janehuff@icloud.com. Entries limited to the first 15 horses.**
- This is a fair-weather event and final determination will be made 24 hours prior to the event start. All registered attendees will be notified if event is cancelled.
- **Each horse/rider combination entry fee is \$35. Horses may be entered with more than one rider. If you don’t have a horse to ride, you may audit this event for \$25. Parents may observe for free!**

Event Schedule:

10am – Arrival time if you are bringing a horse -- you may arrive earlier!

10am – Registration opens.

10:30am – Welcome and Information Meeting.

11am – Rider group 1 “vet in” (vet in is with halter and lead rope only).

11:30am – Rider Group 1 rides out.

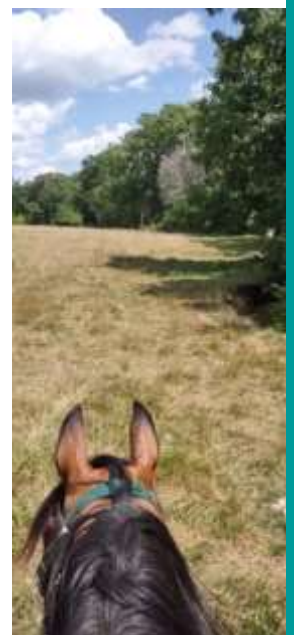
12:30pm – Rider Group 1 returns and finishes with “completion vet check.”

1pm – Rider Group 2 “vet in” (vet in is with halter and lead rope only).

1:30pm – Rider Group 2 rides out.

2:30pm – Rider Group 2 returns and finishes with “completion vet check.”

3pm – Wrap up meeting with Q&A session.



What to bring:

- Chairs for the meeting portion of the event.
- Hay, hay bag, feed (if your horse needs a snack), water buckets (and a way to hang them from your trailer if so desired).
- Your tack including bridle, saddle, saddle pad, halter, and lead rope.
- **Negative Coggins issued in the last 12 months for any horse you are bringing.**
- **Your entry, entry fee, and signed waiver.**

At the event:

- You are responsible for your horse at the event; you may tie your horse to your trailer, hold them, etc.
- This is a primitive campsite; horse water will be provided. The owner is responsible for their horse's feed, hay, and water buckets.
- Please leave your dogs at home. If you do bring a dog, it **MUST** be in your truck or trailer **at all times**.
- **Brockarito Food Truck will be onsite serving lunch. Menu items average \$12/person.**

Directions:

From the North:

US 65 South to Fair Grove Exit (CC 125) turn left at stop sign going over bridge toward Fair Grove proper, proceed ¼ mile past bridge turning Right on to Orchard Blvd. following sign, then go approx. 2 miles (watch for signs) to turn left through double red gates.

From the South:

US 65 North to Fair Grove Exit (CC 125) turn RIGHT at stop sign toward Fair Grove proper, proceed ¼ mile turning Right on to Orchard Blvd. following sign, then go approx. 2 miles (watch for signs) to turn left through double red gates.
